What is Interchange Outer East?

Interchange Outer East (IOE) is a non profit, community based organisation that supports families who have a child or young person with a disability living in Melbourne's outer east. During weekends and/or between camps, volunteers will be hosted by a selected family that is well-known to IOE, such as a staff, volunteer or client family, who matches the interests and personality of the volunteer - we want to make sure the fit is right so that you can have the best possible experience during your down time!
