Not wheelchair accessible





February 2015



Accommodation and transport will be fully wheelchair accessible.

Trip Origins

This trip has come about through

discussions with families who would like their son / daughter who have physical disabilities to be able to go on a holiday overseas. This trip provides fully accessible transport and accommodation and is supported on a higher ratio than other trips.
