

COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

This document provides details testing and isolation requirements for COVID-19 positive cases among Interchange Outer East staff, participants and household contacts.

Positive Case	All Staff: Isolate for 5 days. Notify your team leader/coordinator that you are unable to work on-site/face-to-face during this period. Participants: Isolate for 5 days. Notify relevant coordinator. All workers are to be informed. A risk assessment should be conducted in consultation with the family/coordinator/team leader to assess the need for support and the impact of not providing support during the quarantine period.
Household Contact of a Positive Case	Office Staff Work from home if possible. If you are required to work in the office: Test daily RAT prior to attending the office for five days. Wear N95 mask. Socially distance. Avoid indoor shared break spaces, particularly at mealtimes. Support Workers Daily RAT for five days prior to attending shifts. Wear N95 mask. Monitor for symptoms and isolate if you begin to experience symptoms even if you test negative. Participants Notify relevant coordinator. Workers are to be informed if shifts are in-home and in the presence of the positive case. Shifts should occur out of the home away from the positive case, ideally outside and socially distance. Daily RAT for five days. Wear a mask (unless exempt). Monitor for symptoms.
Other Contacts of a Positive Case	 All Staff and Participants Monitor for symptoms. Test if required. Socially distance where possible.
Vaccination	Staff We encourage all staff to be vaccinated, however there is no longer a requirement to be vaccinated to work at IOE. Participants We encourage all participants to be vaccinated, however there is no requirement to be vaccinated to access programs and services at IOE including IOE group-based supports.

Masks	Staff Staff are required to wear a mask when they are having face-to-face contact with participants that are highly vulnerable or at the request of the participant or family. All other staff may use a mask at their own discretion.
Keeping Yourself Well	 IOE encourages staff and participants to: Book in for a COVID-19 booster and flu vaccination. Maintain social distance. Maintain good hygiene practices wash/sanitise hands frequently. Stay at home if you are experiencing cold and flu symptoms.
Recording COVID-19 Cases	IOE will no longer record positive cases or close contacts. We will continue to collect this information from staff to manage work calendars and working from home arrangements. Information will be collected about participants' COVID-19 status and household contacts to ensure their support requirements are appropriate, and to limit the spread of COVID-19 to staff and other participants.
